James Waslaski is an Author & International Lecturer who teaches approximately 40 seminars per year around the globe. He's served as AMTA Sports Massage Chair and FSMTA Professional Relations Chair. He's developed 8 Orthopedic Massage and Sports Injury DVDs, and authored manuals on Advanced Orthopedic Massage and Client Self Care. His new book: Clinical Massage Therapy: A Structural Approach to Pain Management, was published by Pearson Education in 2011.

James is a Certified Personal Trainer with NASM. He presents at state, national and international massage, chiropractic, and osteopathic conventions, including keynote addresses at the FSMTA, World of Wellness, New England Regional Conference, the World Massage Festival, and Australian National Massage Conventions. His audience includes massage and physical therapists, as well as athletic trainers, chiropractors, osteopaths, nurses and physicians.

James received the 1999 FSMTA International Achievement Award, and was inducted into the 2008 Massage Therapy Hall of Fame. James was also awarded Massage Therapist of the Year by One Concept in Canada as well as Teacher of the year in 2015 by the World Massage Festival.

OPEN POSITIONS FOR ANNUAL ELECTION

The position descriptions below are a shorter, highlighted version of the full-length position descriptions. For the full-length version, please contact Dawn Menning, Interim Awards & Nominations Chair. Thank You. (see Roster for contact information)

♦ Chapter Board Member (formerly VP)

<u>Purpose</u>: Assists the Chapter President in achieving Chapter goals and implementing decisions made by the Chapter Board.

<u>Eligibility</u>: In addition to being a Professional member in good standing and signing the Chapter Volunteer Code of Conduct, she/he must meet the following requirement: Completed one year of AMTA membership.

Is accountable to membership, Chapter Board, and AMTA National Board by virtue of election. This is a 2-year term. Time commitment averages approximately 5-8 hours a week, depending on Chapter activities. The time commitment may be higher before and/or after Chapter events or actions.

Responsibilities: Is a voting member of the Chapter Board. Attends Chapter Board, Chapter membership, and any Chapter committee meetings for which the Chapter Board Member has responsibility. Is available to receive direct feedback from members for input to the Chapter Board, and to communicate appropriate information regarding actions of the Chapter Board. Maintains communication with Chapter membership through regular reports, and reports at Chapter membership and Chapter Board meetings. Maintains orderly records of activities and timelines relevant to his/her position during their term and supplies the incoming Chapter Board Member with those records to ensure a smooth transition.

♦ Chapter Secretary

<u>Purpose</u>: The Chapter Secretary is the official keeper of the Chapter records and is responsible for recording, maintaining and updating Chapter records during her/his term of office.

<u>Eligibility</u>: In addition to being a Professional member in good standing and signing the Chapter Volunteer Code of Conduct, she/he must meet the following requirement: Completed one year of AMTA membership.

Is accountable to membership, Chapter Board, and AMTA National Board by virtue of election. This is a 2-year term. Time commitment is approximately 2-4 hours per week, dependent upon Chapter activities.

Responsibilities Is a voting member of the Chapter Board. Distributes announcements of Chapter Board meetings and Chapter membership meetings.. Attends Chapter Board and membership meetings and ensures that attendance, votes and the proceedings of the meetings are recorded, maintained and retained according to the National record retention guidelines. Submits required reports and volunteer rosters to the National Office. Distributes minutes of Chapter Board meetings to Board members. Provides access to minutes from Chapter meetings to the Chapter membership upon request. Maintains orderly records of activities and timelines relevant to his/her position during their term and supplies the incoming Secretary with those records to ensure a smooth transition.

♦ Alternate to the House of Delegates - Two (2) elected each year.

<u>Purpose</u>: Alternate Delegate stays informed and ready to assume delegate positions (thereafter represents her/his Chapter Members in the HOD and related activities, informs the Chapter of timelines, and facilitates the Chapter's influence in the HOD)

<u>Eligibility</u>: In addition to being a Professional member in good standing and signing the Chapter Volunteer Code of Conduct, she/he must meet the following requirement: Completed one year of AMTA membership. Shall not be a member of the AMTA National Board)

Is accountable to the members of the Chapter by virtue of election. These are 1-year terms. The time commitment averages about 2-4 hours a month, may be more, closer to the gathering of the HOD.

Alternate to the House of Delegates (continued)

Responsibilities: Supporting the purposes and performing responsibilities of the House of Delegates as described in Bylaws, Policy, and Delegate Position Description should they succeed to the position of Delegate. Maintains a working knowledge of materials prior to the HOD, Prepares and reviews all necessary materials prior to meetings and attends the Chapter Annual Business meetings.

Note: The HODCC provides materials and training.

The Awards and Nominations Chair

<u>Purpose</u>: To gather nominations for Chapter Awards and Chapter Elections. Assist the Board in Elections process and Awards process.

<u>Eligibility:</u> a Professional member in good standing and signing the Chapter Volunteer Code of Conduct.

Is accountable to the chapter board by virtue of appointment and reports to the chapter president or designated Board Member. The term is one (1) year or until successor is appointed. Time commitment is approximately five (5) hours per week, however, the time will vary by quantity and type of projects underway.

Responsibility: Works closely with the Board of Directors to prepare /present for the elections and awards part of the Annual Chapter Membership Meeting. Write articles for the chapter newsletter (open positions for elections, seeking awards nominations, awards articles, Membership Spotlight, announcements, etc..) Maintains communication with Chapter Membership through regular reports, and reports at Chapter Membership and Chapter Board Meetings. Maintains orderly records of activities and timelines relevant to his/her position during their term and supplies the incoming Awards and Nominations Chair with those records to ensure a smooth transition.

♦ Certificate of Appreciation

- Can be awarded to amta member or non-member
- Recipient(s) are to have contributed to enrich the lives of others and promote awareness of massage which may or may not include massage.

♦ Meritorious Award

- Active amta member for at least one year
- Acknowledges diligent volunteerism done in an altruistic manner
- Only one nominee from each chapter can be a recipient

Distinguished Service Award

- Must be an amta member and massage therapist
- There can be more than one recipient in any given year
- Recipient must contribute to the massage profession in outstanding manner
- Recipient shall not have received this awarded in the previous year
- Acknowledges diligent volunteerism done in an altruistic manner
- ** Please contact any member of the Chapter Board or myself (Dawn) if you know anyone who would be a great nominee for any of these awards. We are interested in hearing who your nominations would be and why. Thank-you!! **
