2-Day Workshop: Massage and Cancer: Finding the New Normal (16 CEUs)

Course description: Because cancer is a disease that impacts so many, that there is little doubt that massage therapists will encounter a client with a history of cancer in their practice. Massage and Cancer: Finding the New Normal is a 16 CE workshop is focused on providing touch therapists with an understanding of cancer, a review of various therapies involved in the treatment of cancer and focus on long term and late term effects. These effects will impact the delivery of an informed and supportive massage therapy session. This class will be a blend of lecture, hands on practice with other students in the class, and group exercises.

Items needed for workshop: massage table, 2 pillows, sheets, towels, massage oil/lotion. Wear loose, comfortable clothing.

Mary Aguilera-Titus, BA, LMT, BCTMB has been in practice since 2002. She comes from a close knit family of seven, and when two of her sisters passed away in the summer of 2006 from breast cancer, the experience left an indelible mark and formed much of her approach and desire to support those living with cancer. Knowing that skilled touch can be a powerful support to people impacted by a diagnosis of cancer, Mary has focused much of her work in the field of oncology massage.

Since 2009, she has been part of the Palliative Care Service interdisciplinary team at Suburban Hospital, providing inpatient massage therapy. Mary is also part of the Integrative Medicine Service at Sibley Memorial Hospital, providing outpatient massage therapy. Both hospitals are affiliated with Johns Hopkins Medicine. She is also an instructor with Oncology Massage Education Associates, offering education to other massage therapists. Mary is a charter member of the Society for Oncology Massage, and serves as chair of the Education Committee.

Day 2 Workshop: Structural Release of the Abdominals & Psoas (8 CEUs)

STRUCTURAL RELEASE will teach the theory and techniques for structural realignment of the body.

This can enable you to integrate and combine the conscious awareness of body, mind and spirit to facilitate advanced states of healing. The intent of the treatments is to balance the body into alignment with its environment, freeing the energy flow that will enhance the body's physiological and psychological function.

The Hip course will assess and balance a tilted and rotated pelvis. A balanced pelvis will lead to structural integrity of the whole body.

The Abdominal course will release the diaphragm and abdominal cavity and free the psoas to increase and maintain the clients structural integrity.

During these workshops: We will review the anatomical structure of the areas being taught, learn structural assessment for the areas, learn the hands-on techniques and **give and receive a two hour session.** You will be able to immediately integrate the information learned in these courses into your current practice.


