







- Then after making sure you are eligible, I send it off to **Simple Voting** the team that facilitates our online voting.
- But first things first, you must go into your AMTA account and make sure your email and personal information is current. Please do that, so you will be getting the election information. The votes are received and tallied by a second party (*Simple Voting*) and the only way for them to contact you is through your email.

**AMTA National made changes to chapter boards configuration.** We will now only have five board members; President, Secretary, Financial Administrator, Board Member and Board Member. This year the openings will be for the Financial Administrator (new name for Treasurer) and 1- Board Member.

Remember, if you are not interested in a board position, you could still be a part of a committee. Check the Calendar of Events for dates.

I need to receive your email request by 9:00 AM, the Monday before the meeting. Once I receive your request, I will send you login information for GoToWebinar. If you do not receive the login information from me by 9:00 AM the day of the



meeting, please call or text me and I will resend the information to you.

To ensure you are able to be a panelist and hear the meeting, it is recommended that you download "GoToWebinar" on whatever electronic device you plan on using for the meeting. Also, make sure the speakers on your device work properly. One issue we found is, if your internet is slow, you may have a difficult time hearing the meeting.

During the meeting, panelists will be able to type in questions. We will be monitoring the incoming questions and trying to address them as time allows. The agenda for the meeting will be in "handouts" in our meeting. I will try to have the agenda on the screen if you have the ability to see the shared screen.

Please know we are trying to make this work flawlessly, as we want your participation. However, understand that with technology, things don't always go as planned. Be patient, check the website for any changes or updates to our meetings or how to attend a meeting.
